# **Iosco County Community Foundation Philanthropist of the Year Award**

#### **Background**

The **losco County Community Foundation Philanthropist of the Year Award** was awarded for the first time in 2012. This award is meant to honor those who make a difference in our communities through their philanthropic activities, including financial contributions that benefit their community; volunteering; and giving of their time, resources and skills for the betterment of the community.

#### **Qualifications**

Nominee must be an losco County resident with a continuing history of volunteer work and contributions that advance the quality of life for the people of losco County through:

- Community leadership
- Financial commitment/charitable contributions to local organization(s)
- Advocacy for local cause(s)
- Board service in the non-profit sector

#### **Eligibility**

Nominee must donate time and resources to non-profit(s) in losco County. (Past nominees who have not received the award **ARE** eligible for re-nomination for the Philanthropist of the Year Award.) Current ICCF board members and members of their immediate family, as well as Community Foundation staff are ineligible for nomination. \*Note – this award may be awarded posthumously. If this is the case, the nominee's death must have occurred during the current calendar year.

#### **Selection and Recognition**

The losco County Community Foundation (ICCF) Board will review all nominations and select the award winner. The nominators will be notified of the status of their nomination by April 15. The recipient will be honored with the award at a luncheon/event in May.

#### **Nomination Process/Guidelines**

- 1. Complete the Nomination Form and answer the questions provided. If you need additional space to provide your answers, please attach additional pages (no more than three).
- 2. Include <u>at least one</u> letter of recommendation (additional letters are optional) from a person familiar with the nominee's philanthropic and volunteer activities. (This person should not be a family member of the nominee.)
- 3. All nominations are due by March 1<sup>st</sup>.
