In October 2019, the Iosco County Community Foundation partnered with the Oscoda AuSable Nonprofit Roundtable and Tri-County Agency, Inc. to bring "Nonprofit Board Basics" to Iosco County. Nearly 30 representatives from local organizations attended the session in Oscoda, led by Julie-Ann Rivers Cochran of Blackbird Consulting. 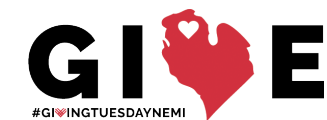
