In 2023, Cheboygan County Habitat for Humanity established a permanent endowment fund at the Straits Area Community Foundation (SACF). The new fund will be used specifically to support the organization's Homeownership Program which helps people to be able to purchase an affordable home through the building of houses and rehabilitation of existing structures.



Cheboygan Habitat for Humanity was given a \$100,000 donation from The Martin and Patricia Jahn Foundation specifically so the organization could establish the endowment fund at SACF to ensure the Homeownership program can be supported for generations to come.
