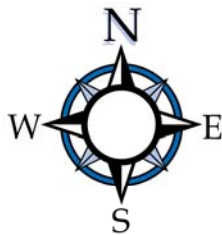


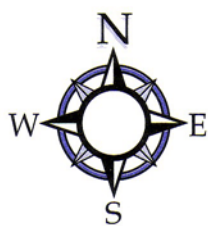

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

On behalf of the Trustees and staff of the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan (CFNEM), and its affiliates: Iosco County Community Foundation; North Central Michigan Community Foundation; and Straits Area Community Foundation, I am proud and privileged to present this 2011 Annual Report.

Since 1974, CFNEM has helped make donors' charitable dreams come true by funding the nonprofits that make our region a vital and secure place. While our assets, just like the economy in Northeast Michigan, were still recovering from the down market of a couple of years ago, we ended our 2011 fiscal year with assets totaling \$19,894,351 and received gifts of \$622,191, including those from a record breaking 391 first-time donors. We welcomed 15 new funds to our family in 2011 and distributed \$1,164,088 in grants and scholarships.

Despite the current economic environment, the power of CFNEM's endowment gave us the ability to provide the same level of competitive grant support in 2011 as we have in the past. Endowment differentiates us from many other funding sources and gives us the capacity and flexibility to respond to emerging and immediate community needs – especially in challenging economic times when our communities need us the most.

Along with the work we do in grantmaking, CFNEM has taken a leadership role in Northeast Michigan. From issues relating to fighting homelessness and hunger, ensuring college access for all area students or funding environmental place-based education, to advocating for positive behavioral health in our children, we have been at the table to work with others to overcome obstacles and improve the lives of our residents, now and in the future. As the economy continues to challenge, we will continue to look for opportunities to lead and collaborate with others to help make sure Northeast Michigan remains a wonderful place to live.

Another year of CFNEM's growth and continued community impact was made possible through the generosity of our donors. We measure our success by the growing number of Northeast Michigan residents who partner with CFNEM in making this a better place in which to live, work and play. Whether you're giving today, or endowing a fund to support a cause or solve problems for the future, your Community Foundation makes it easy to be a philanthropist. We invite you to learn about us and how you can join our family of donors.

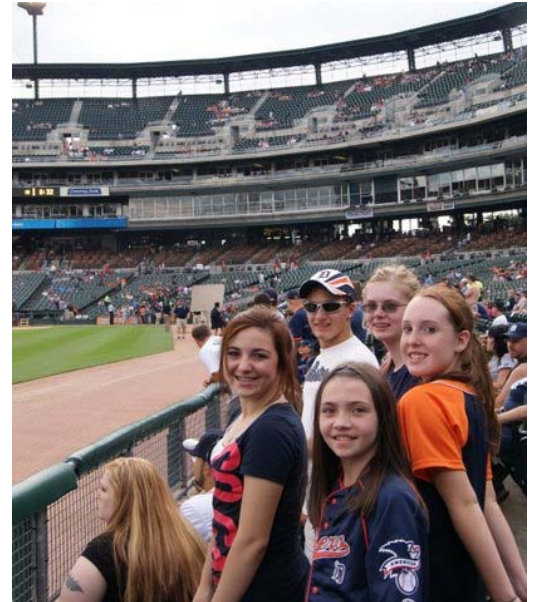

Northeast Michigan Youth Advisory Council (NEMYAC)



NEMYAC is a permanent committee of the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan (CFNEM) and is comprised of approximately 60 students and eight adult advisors from the counties of Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency, and Presque Isle. Since April of 1993, YAC members have recommended over \$850,000 in grants for the four county service area. Thanks to a challenge grant from the W. K. Kellogg Foundation, CFNEM's YAC has over \$1 million permanently endowed in a youth field-of-interest fund. The fund provides nearly \$50,000 each year to be allocated for youth related programs and projects.

Affiliate Youth Advisory Councils (YAC)

CFNEM's affiliate Youth Advisory Councils (YAC) award grants each year to youth programs in their communities. Young people in Iosco County (ICCF), Crawford, Ogemaw and Oscoda Counties (NCMCF), and Cheboygan County and Mackinaw City (SACF) benefit from these grants. YAC members learn about the power of philanthropy, and it empowers them to make a real difference in their communities through grantmaking and service.
