## Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan Awards 31 New Grants Totaling \$44,857

**ALPENA**—The Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan (CFNEM) recently awarded a new round of community grants covering a four-county area that includes Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency and Presque Isle Counties. The Board of Trustees recently approved 31 new grants totaling \$44,857 during its March quarterly meeting.

This round of grant applications was due on Feb. 1, 2015 and was a very competitive cycle. "While we strive to increase the grant dollars available each year to serve the growing needs of our local communities, it continues to be a challenge to do so. For this most recent cycle, we had a two-to-one request for every dollar available," said CFNEM Executive Director Barbara Frantz.

"One of the funding needs that seems to be growing across the four-county area we serve, as well as for the five counties our regional affiliate foundations serve, is the request to help stock student back packs, food pantries and clothing closets for school-age youth and families," added Frantz. "We have always had these requests during the winter holiday season," said Frantz, "but now we are receiving requests to support food distribution programs all year round."

The next deadline for grant applications is August 1, 2015. Grant application forms and criteria are available at www.cfnem.org. Please note that CFNEM has recently changed the name of its "Common Grants" to "Community Impact Grants" to better reflect their purpose.
