## CFNEM and Affiliate Youth Advisory Councils (YACs)

Youth Advisory Councils are permanent committees of CFNEM and its affiliates. They are comprised of approximately 130 students and thirteen adult advisors from the counties of Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency, and Presque Isle for CFNEM, and for our affiliates, the counties of Cheboygan, Crawford, Iosco, Ogemaw and Oscoda. Since April of 1993, YAC members have recommended over \$900,000 in grants for our entire service area. Thanks to a challenge grant from the W.K.Kellogg Foundation, our YACs have nearly \$1.8 million permanently endowed in youth field-of-interest funds. The funds provide approximately \$75,000 each year to be allocated for youth related programs and projects.











YAC grants provide new experiences and help teach new skills and sportsmanship.



During the 2010 fiscal year, the affiliate YACs awarded nearly \$22,000 in grants to youth programs in their communities. Through these grants, the YAC members learn about the power of philanthropy, and it empowers them to make a real difference in their communities, not only through their grantmaking, but also through service.









Leadership, grantmaking, community service and philanthropy are the four main focuses of a YAC member's experience on the Youth Advisory Council.



Anyone can establish a fund with the Community Foundation, but you don't need to establish a fund to make a contribution. Anyone can contribute to any of the following funds at any time, in any amount. The purpose of each fund varies with the charitable intent of the original donor, providing donors with a wide variety of philanthropic choices.
