A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT


If you think a community foundation is a non-profit organization created by local residents to improve their communities, you're right. But that's just the beginning. I am honored to share with you this annual report of what the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan (CFNEM) and its three affiliates: Iosco County Community Foundation, North Central Michigan Community Foundation, and Straits Area Community Foundation, accomplished in 2013.

We work with donors, grantees, advisers and our communities to identify and support the issues that shape northeast Michigan. By bringing people together around a common mission, and creating links between resources and the donor's vision for the future, we're helping ensure that our communities remain vital and strong. We seek to effect positive change in the communities we serve by awarding grants to benefit the arts, community development, education, the environment, youth, health and human services, and emerging community needs. Through funds started by generous donors who care about developing the minds and skills of the next generation, we award scholarships of all sizes, to benefit all kinds of students. The bottom line: It's about loving where you live.

2013 was a banner year for CFNEM. We completed our fiscal year on September 30, 2013 with assets of \$28,418,210, representing overall growth of 17%. We received a total of \$2,056,941 in gifts for the year and awarded grants and scholarships of \$972,268.

The biggest news for our 2013 fiscal year was that we moved into beautiful new offices. Our new address is 100 N. Ripley St., Suite F, located at the corner of Washington and Ripley in Alpena. This new space is much larger than our old offices. As CFNEM has grown in assets over the years, we needed to have a home that reflected that growth and offered room for more growth. One of the most exciting aspects of our new home is that we have two conference rooms: one small that seats eight and one large that easily seats thirty with room for more. We offer these conference rooms available to community organizations for meetings at no cost. It's a way for us to give back and build relationships as more and more people visit us and get to know us better.

We owe a deep thanks to our donors. None of what we do would be possible if not for those who make a conscious effort to give back to their community. Donors who love northeast Michigan, whether they have supported CFNEM or any of its three affiliates, whether they are new donors or have supported us for many years, we exist to serve them. The wonderful result of their generosity is that since we were created back in 1974 we have made grants of nearly \$26 million to support the changing needs of the many communities we serve here in northeast Michigan. We have made a positive difference all because our donors loved northeast Michigan and cared enough to give back.

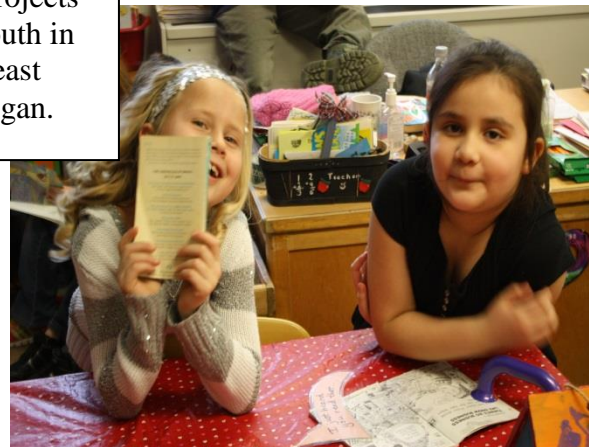
Northeast Michigan Youth Advisory Council (NEMYAC)



NEMYAC is a permanent committee of the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan (CFNEM) and is comprised of approximately 60 students and eight adult advisors from the counties of Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency, and Presque Isle. Since April of 1993, YAC members have recommended nearly \$900,000 in grants for the four county service area. Thanks to a challenge grant from the W.K.Kellogg Foundation, CFNEM's YAC has over \$1 million permanently endowed in a youth field-of-interest fund. The fund provides nearly \$50,000 each year to be allocated for youth related programs and projects.

Affiliate Youth Advisory Councils (YAC)

CFNEM's affiliate Youth Advisory Councils (YAC) award grants each year to youth programs in their communities. Young people in Iosco County (ICCF), Crawford, Ogemaw and Oscoda Counties (NCMCF), and Cheboygan County and Mackinaw City (SACF) benefit from these grants. YAC members learn about the power of philanthropy, and it empowers them to make a real difference in their communities through grantmaking and service.

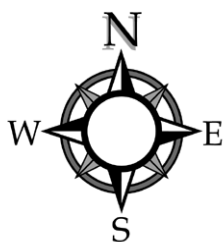
