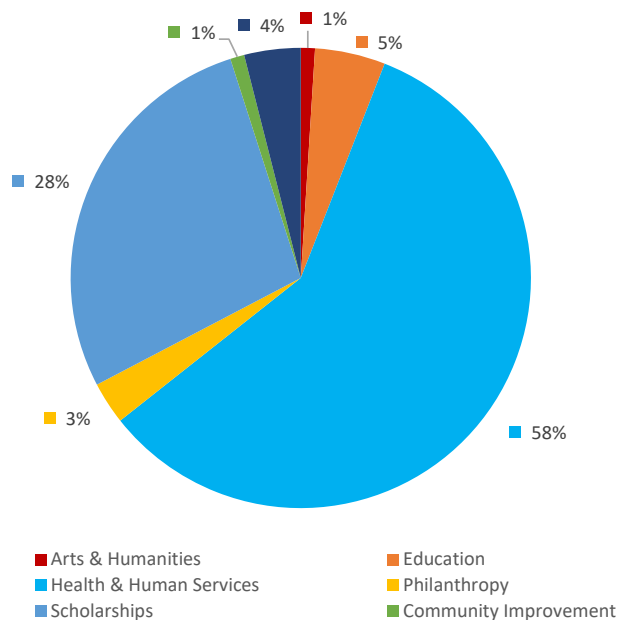

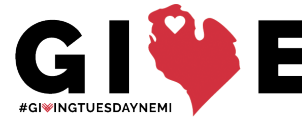

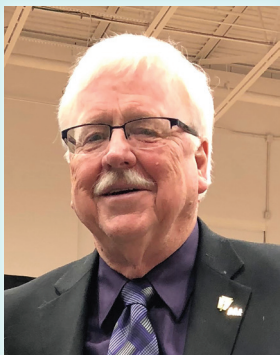

Mr. Haskin taught at Tawas Area High School for 35 years. According to Lynn Kubisiak and Stacey Mochty, who nominated Haskin, his teaching experience allowed him to create connections with students, parents, colleagues and the community through many leadership roles. Among those roles were, and still are, involvement in Tawas Bay Players, as a National Honor Society advisor, the Tawas sports programs, Perchville, and many more.
